Thank you for participating in the Borough of Milltown's Independence Day Celebration. The Borough and the Milltown Fourth of July Organization are excited for your participation in the parade.

The Borough would like to address with all participants in the parade the rules and regulations as outlined by the local ordinances of the Borough. The Borough Code of the Borough of Milltown addresses noise and limits volume, frequency and amplification of sound. The Borough Police are encouraged to use discretion during the events, however, they are charged with keeping peace and order of the Borough and must enforce the local ordinances if they are being violated. All participants will be subject to all provisions of the ordinances.

Please be mindful of the following noise amplifications that will be monitored for excessive use while on the parade route as we have received multiple complaints by residents and parade attendees; this list includes but is not limited to:

- Honking Horns
- Signals, sirens or similar being sounded
- Use of loudspeakers, radios, instruments, or other machine/device to amplify sound
- The use of any sound amplifier which includes but is not limited to radio, musical instruments, loudspeaker or megaphone.

If the Police Department determines the noise is a violation of the ordinance, a ticket **will** be issued and the apparatus will immediately be escorted off of the parade route.
